Course delivery options

In person: Students attend class at KCC during specific times and days. Students and professors interact face-to-face in small class sizes. Whenever needed, applicable physical distancing and other established health and safety measures are followed.

Online and Hybrid courses: When enrolled in online and hybrid courses, students should be ready to ask and answer questions, participate in discussions, and take tests online. These courses require a reliable Internet connection (preferably high-speed). Students in online and hybrid courses must understand basic computing, email, word processing and Internet navigation.

Hybrid course: Hybrid courses combine face-to-face and online instruction and activities. Course instructors will explain specific course requirements to students in detail during their first on-campus meeting or online interaction.

Online course: All content/instruction is online and accessible through KCC's learning management system (Canvas) with regular and substantive interaction between students and the instructor. Students can finish an online course without coming to KCC's campus, but may be required to take tests/assessments in a pre-approved testing center.

KCC se asegurará de que a ningún discapacitado que cualifique, sólo por ser discapacitado se le excluya de la participación, o se le denieguen los beneficios, o se le discrimine en programa alguno, o actividad del colegio, según los requisitos de la sección 504 del Acta de Rehabilitación de 1973 y del Acta para Estadounidenses con Discapacidades de 1990.
